Beginning with firmware version n20, the Model 3002 will require the use of Lumic 2.0 for calibration or configuration purposes.

Customers wishing to continue to use earlier versions of firmware and Lumic software may continue to do so; however, no new features or bug fixes will be made to prior versions of firmware or software as we focus on supporting our new releases.

As always, the new firmware updates will be made available soon on our website for free to any customer who wishes to update any of the instruments listed above. If you purchased the original Lumic software, you are eligible for a FREE copy of Lumic 2.0. Please contact your local sales representative or Ludlum Measurements to receive your copy.

Finally, if at any time you are unsure as to which Lumic software to use to calibrate an instrument, we recommend that you connect the instrument to Lumic 2.0 first. Lumic 2.0 will check the instrument and inform you if you need to use an earlier version of Lumic software.
